Jesus Happens

Jesus concluded His Sermon on the Mount with a comparison of two houses. He said a person who will hear and obey God's word is like a wise man who builds his house upon a rock. Jesus also said a person who will neither hear or obey God's word is like a foolish man who builds his home upon sand. But, herein is the crux of Jesus' teaching: He said rain, floods, and wind beat on both houses (Matt. 7:24-27).

Sure, we expected the house built on rock to wether the storm, and we were not surprised when the house built on sand fell; but, both houses were tried. In other words, stuff happens to both obedient and disobedient folks. Jesus was not teaching righteous people's lives will be without storms. He was teaching storms come upon all people and righteous people are better equipped to weather those storms.

We live in a culture where victim mentalities run rampant. Folks, stuff happens: economies sour, cars crash, people get cancer, children rebel, sons go to war, and companies reorganize. The fact that storms beat on both house-types ought not surprise us. Many of us are not surprised when a storm decends upon someone else, but for some reason, we are surprised when it happens to us.

We ought not wonder if a trial will befall us, but when a trial will befall us. If we live long enough, we will face a storm or two or three. Jesus is telling us to expect storms. How ought we build a storm proof house? Build our houses on rock, and that Rock is Jesus Christ - I Corinthians 10:4.

When rain, wind, and floods beat on storm proof houses, shingles may need refastening, carpet may need replacing, yards will need cleaning; however, the Rock will deliver the house. And great is the fall, when there is not a Rock.

Dear All.




